Areas Covered by ESSER III

CARES ESSER III FUNDS		
Learning Recovery	Any connection that provides resources to families working to recovery learning time is valid for an ESSER III disbursement.	
Special Populations	Communications services that support marginalized student populations, including those with limited access to resources like WiFi, limited mobility, or learning challenges, are ESSER III-eligible.	
Emergency Preparedness	ESSER III supports all planning and coordinating efforts for emergency response and prevention.
